

**WARRICK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**  
**ORDINANCE NUMBER 1999-9**

WHEREAS, there has been growing concern with regard to safety and disruption of traffic flow surrounding individuals soliciting in, around or near certain intersections contained within Warrick County; and

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners wish to prevent such safety hazards and disruption of traffic flow.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the Board of Commissioners of Warrick County, Indiana, hereby require the following:

Section 1. That any and all individuals, entities, and/or organizations of any type who wish to solicit in any manner on or about any street or intersection of streets must first obtain a permit to be issued by the Warrick County Commissioners.

Section 2. That an application for such permit must be filed with the Warrick County Commissioners Office no less than thirty (30) days prior to the proposed solicitation date(s).

Section 3. That a public hearing with regard to said application shall take place at the next regular session of the Warrick County Commissioners or special session if so called by the Warrick County Commissioners.

Section 4. That if said application is granted, a permit designating the specific time, place and manner of such solicitations must be carried at all solicitation times on the person(s) of the individual(s) performing the solicitations.


Section 5. That each violation of this ordinance may be punished by a fine not exceeding Two Thousand Five Hundred (\$2,500.00) Dollars per violation.


Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect September 13, 1999.

Passed this 13<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1999.


