ORDINANCE NUMBER 1999-41

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING
AROUND THE COURTHOUSE SQUARE

WHEREAS, the County of Warrick is the effective owner and real party in interest of certain real estate located within the City of Boonville in Warrick County, Indiana, which is commonly referred to as the "courthouse square" and more particularly described as follows:

The Public Square as recorded in Plat book No. 1, Page 20 in the Office of the Recorder of Warrick County, Indiana, and further described as being bound by Main Street, Third Street, Locust Street and Second Street; and

WHEREAS, on Monday, September 13, 1999, the Warrick County Commissioners voted unanimously to declare the purported contract entered into with the City of Boonville dated March 6, 1950 regulating parking around the courthouse square to be null and void; and

WHEREAS, the Warrick County Commissioners believe it is in the best interests of Warrick County taxpayers to provide for regulation of parking within the perimeters of said courthouse square.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the Board of Commissioners of Warrick County, Indiana, hereby require the following:

Section 1. That the parking around the courthouse square be regulated and assigned as follows:

A. On the North side of the courthouse square certain parking spaces be designated as follows: (2) Handicap, (2) Police, (2) No Parking at fire hydrants, and (6) 30 minute parking only, and (7) 1 hour parking only.

B. On the East side of the courthouse square certain parking spaces be designated as follows: (2) Handicap, (2) No Parking at fire hydrants, and (3) 30 minute parking only at North End, and (13) permit parking only.

C. On the South side of the courthouse square certain parking spaces be designated as follows: (2) Police, (2) No Parking at fire hydrants, and (16) permit parking only.

D. On the West side of the courthouse square certain parking spaces be designated as follows: (2) No Parking at fire hydrants, and (18) permit parking only.

Section 2. The specific assignment by the Warrick County Commissioners of parking spaces, and the manner by which permit parking is designated, shall be accomplished through the issuing of written permits to be prominently displayed in the various vehicles by the permit holders.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect _____, 1999.
