RESOLUTION 1999-4

**A RESOLUTION DISAPPROVING, DENYING
AND REJECTING PROPOSED RATE INCREASE BY
WARRICK CABLEVISION / CENTURY COMMUNICATIONS CORP.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 76 et al, Warrick County is the local certified franchising authority with the power to deny or approve basic cable rate increases in Warrick County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, Century Communications Corporation pursuant to Ordinance 1995-9 through its umbrella or predecessor company Warrick Cablevision, Inc., entered into a Cable Television Franchise Agreement with the said Warrick County for the purpose of providing basic cable service within Warrick County; and

WHEREAS, through its attached letter of January 28, 1999 the franchisee submitted a request to increase its basic cable rates and such letter failed to provide the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") Forms 1240 and 1205; and

WHEREAS, the Warrick County Commissioners have reviewed the request and determined that such request is neither reasonable nor necessary and should not be granted; and

WHEREAS, the franchising authority has ninety (90) days from the date of the filing to review such a request pursuant to 47 C.F. 76.933(g); and

WHEREAS, Warrick Cablevision, Inc. or Century Communications Corporation has continuously violated Section 7 of the Cable Television Franchise Agreement entered into pursuant to Ordinance No. 1995-9 in that it continuously produces a picture that is distorted and signal quality

that is less than adequate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

Section 1. The Warrick County Commissioners as the franchising authority hereby disapproves, rejects and denies any and all portions of such proposed rate increase.


Section 2. That pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 76.933(g)(3) the Cable Operator is hereby not permitted to implement such a rate increase and must inform its subscribers that it has not been permitted to implement such an increase within sixty (60) days of this decision.


Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately.


