RESOLUTION OF WARRICK COUNTY, INDIANA
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF THE
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT APPLICATION
TO THE INDIANA HOUSING FINANCE AUTHORITY
AND ADDRESSING RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Warrick County Commissioners, recognize the need to stimulate growth and to maintain affordable housing within its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, authorizes the Indiana Housing Finance Authority to provide grants to local units of government, and/or qualified not-for-profit organizations to meet the affordable housing and community development needs of low and moderate income persons; and

WHEREAS, the Warrick County Commissioners, have conducted or will conduct public hearings prior to the submission of an application to the Indiana Housing Finance Authority, said public hearings to assess the housing, public facilities, and economic needs of low and moderate income residents;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Warrick County Commissioners;


1. The Chief Elected Official (CEO) is authorized to prepare and submit an application for \$30,000 in Community Development Block Grant funding to address conditions relating to housing, Warrick County, Indiana, and to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indiana Housing Finance Authority and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
2. The Warrick County Commissioners, Indiana, with the prior fiscal approval from the Warrick County Council, commit the requisite local funds in the amount of three thousand three hundred Dollars (\$3,300), such commitment to be contingent upon receipt of CDBG funding from the Indiana Housing Finance Authority. The anticipated source of this leverage is County General Funding.

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



On or about December 23, 2000, the Warrick County Commissioners intend to apply to the Indiana Housing Finance Authority for a grant from the State Community Development Block Grant Program. The program is funded by Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. The funds are to be used for economic development, public facilities, and housing. The purpose of this application shall be for completing a housing needs assessment for Warrick County.

The Warrick County Commissioners will hold a public hearing on December 13, 2000 at 2:30 p.m., Warrick County Commissioner's Meeting Room, 107 W. Locust Street, Boonville, IN 47601, to provide citizens with an opportunity to express their views on community development and housing needs, past community development and housing activities, and the proposed housing needs assessment project.

Records regarding the accounting of these beneficiaries and funds are available from the Warrick County Commissioner's Office, 107 W. Locust Street, Boonville, IN 47061. Interested citizens are invited to provide comments regarding these issues either at the public hearing or by prior written statement. Accommodations will be made for the individuals with disabilities and the non-English speaking. Please alert the County of any special needs at least 48 hours in advance of the hearing. A plan to minimize displacement and provide assistance to those displaced has been prepared and is available to the public.
