

**Warrick County Commissioners Ordinance No. 2005 - 48**  
**An Ordinance Establishing a Local Advisory Council**  
**in Compliance with the Help America Vote Act**

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners of Warrick County, Indiana, is the county legislative body of said county; and

Whereas, the Warrick County Commissioners have passed resolutions concerning the accessibility of polling places and the administration of HAVA funds; and

Whereas, Section 4 of said resolutions requires the county legislative body to adopt an ordinance to establish a local advisory council that includes representatives of the disabilities community and elderly voters to provide assistance to the county in choosing polling places;


Now therefore, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Warrick County, Indiana, that the Warrick County Local Advisory Council is hereby established, with the council to include at least two (2) representatives of the disabilities community or elderly voters.


