**A PROCLAMATION RECOGNIZING  
THE 2006 MEMORY WALK**

**WHEREAS**, on October 15, 2006, the annual Alzheimer's Memory Walk will be held at the University of Southern Indiana, and

**WHEREAS**, 1 in 10 people over 65 years old suffer from Alzheimer's, almost half of those 85 years old or older suffer its effects, over 11,000 people suffer the ravages of the disease in the tri-state and 4.5 million Americans have it, and

**WHEREAS**, over 500,000 Americans between the age of 30 and 65 have this degenerative, memory-robbing form of dementia, and

**WHEREAS**, in the next three decades 16 million people will have the disease, and

**WHEREAS**, it is currently the 4<sup>th</sup> leading cause of death in the United States, and

**WHEREAS**, The Greater Kentucky and Southern Indiana Chapter of the Alzheimer's Association conducts the Memory Walk to raise funds to fight the disease.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED** that Sunday, October 15, 2006, is hereby declared to be Memory Walk Day in Warrick County and all citizens are encouraged to join in the fight to defeat Alzheimer's disease, witness our hand and seal this 11<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2006.


