RESOLUTION NO. 2010 - 09

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND AUTHORIZING THE
EXPENDITURE OF CUMULATIVE CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT FUNDS
FOR NON-BRIDGE PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, Warrick County Commissioners' Ordinance No. 1993-11 was passed on June 28, 1993 to enact and/or extend a Cumulative Capital Development Fund; and

WHEREAS, a significant surplus is projected to exist in the Cumulative Capital Development (CCD) Fund by the end of calendar year 2010; and

WHEREAS, the public health, welfare and safety is in immediate danger that requires the expenditure of money in the CCD fund; and

WHEREAS, the public health, welfare or safety is in immediate danger for the following reasons: The Chandler EMS Station located at Fuquay Road and Gardner Road is inadequate to house new EMS ambulances that serve to protect the public health, welfare and safety. Ambulances must be able to be stored in standby mode inside a climate-controlled facility in order to keep medicines and other medical supplies stored at the proper temperature and humidity in order to be correctly administered to citizens being served by the EMS ambulances stationed at the Chandler facility; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners have determined that an expenditure of \$ 350,000.00 in CCD funds is needed to address the above-described emergency situation which demands immediate action.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WARRICK COUNTY, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

That \$ 350,000.00 should be expended from the CCD fund to address the emergency situation described above and to protect the public health, welfare and safety which is in immediate danger as a result of the above-described emergency.


