*Declaration to Use Cumulative Capital Development Funds for
Warrick County Courthouse Repair*

Whereas, Indiana Code 36-9-14.5-8, (c) (1) provides for the expenditure of cumulative capital development funds for purposes other than those stated in section 2 of the chapter, if the purpose is to protect the public health, welfare, or safety in an emergency situation that demands immediate action; and

Whereas, money may be spent under the authority of the subsection only after the county executive issues a declaration that the public health, welfare, or safety is in immediate danger that requires the expenditure of money in the fund;


Now, therefore, the Board of Commissioners of Warrick County, Indiana hereby issues the following declaration:


That an emergency situation exists whereby the public health, welfare, and safety are in immediate danger that requires the expenditure of money in the Cumulative Capital Development Fund for the following purpose:

To fund repairs to the Courthouse cupola, Clock Tower's roof, and clock faces. Past and continuing penetration/exposure to rain water as a result of deteriorating wood, caulking, etc., has created a condition of rotting and weakening wood structures that could result in a catastrophic failure/collapse. In addition, water exposure to the historic Warrick County Courthouse Clock, a #16 Seth Thomas clock installed in 1905 and completely restored in 1995, must also be prevented. All repairs must be made to protect the public health, welfare and safety.
