

Warrick County Ordinance #2013- 25

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF WARRICK COUNTY AMENDING SECTION 135.18
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES**

WHEREAS, §135.18 (A) of the Warrick County Code of Ordinances (hereinafter "Code") currently requires permits to be acquired for tattoo parlors; and

WHEREAS, permits acquired under § 135.18(A) expire December 31st of the year of purchase; and

WHEREAS, the Code establishes a permit fee of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) and said amount is fixed at said rate, regardless of what time of year the permit is acquired; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it appropriate to establish a pro-rated cost schedule for the permit required under § 135.18(A).

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
WARRICK COUNTY, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Subsection (A) of Section § 135.18 of the Code of Ordinances entitled "PERMITS", is hereby struck in its entirety and shall hereby be replaced with the following:


"(A) Business. Each tattoo parlor operation shall obtain a permit from the County Health Department. The permit shall provide the name and address of the owner of the business and the name and address of each and every tattoo artist located at each location. The cost for this permit shall be as indicated on the table below and shall not be transferable. The permit expires on December 31 of each year. Any holder of a permit shall be subject to inspection as set forth herein. The County Health Department shall provide the appropriate forms for this permit. Said permit shall be posted at the tattoo parlor in the place where the tattoos are performed and shall be clearly visible to the public.

1. Permits acquired January 1 through and including March 31 shall be \$500.00.
2. Permits acquired April 1 through and including June 30 shall be \$375.00.
3. Permits acquired July 1 through and including September 30 shall be \$250.00.


4. Permits acquired October 1 through and including December 31 shall be \$125.00."
2. This ordinance, amending the Code of Ordinances of Warrick County, Indiana, will become effective upon passage.


