127th Annual Labor Day Celebration and Parade
Proclamation 2013 - 09



WHEREAS, the Indiana Territorial Legislature passed an act that formed two new counties in southwestern Indiana, namely the Counties of Warrick to the South and Gibson to the North, effective April 1, 1813; and

WHEREAS, Warrick County was named after Capt. Jacob Warrick, a personal friend of General William Henry Harrison, who fought Tecumseh's Indiana Confederation at the Battle of Tippecanoe in 1811, where he was mortally wounded and died as the battle was turning in favor of Harrison's troops; and

WHEREAS, the citizens and communities of the great County of Warrick have banded together and have elected to honor the pioneers of the County and its founding in 1813, and have initiated a year long celebration of the 200th Anniversary of the founding of Warrick County; and

WHEREAS, the Warrick County Bicentennial Steering Committee has recognized as an Official Bicentennial Event the 127th ANNUAL LABOR DAY CELEBRATION AND PARADE to be held in Boonville, Indiana, the weekend of August 30-September 2, 2013; and


WHEREAS, at the 127th ANNUAL LABOR DAY CELEBRATION AND PARADE is sponsored by the Labor Day Association, and will include numerous events at the Warrick County Fairgrounds including carnival rides, food booths, contests, talent shows, a Fiddling Championship, a tractor pull and a demolition derby. The celebrations end with the Labor Day Parade in Boonville on Labor Day.


