

SLUM AND BLIGHT SPOT DECLARATORY RESOLUTION

WARRICK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION No. 2016- 05

WHEREAS, the Warrick County Board of Commissioners desires to redevelop a blighted structure within the corporate limits of Boonville, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the structure located at 124 E. Main Street, Boonville, IN, is listed on the National Register of Historic Places #NR-0150, and has received no income since the Senior Citizens Center vacated the building in July of 2006, and

WHEREAS, deterioration of the structure has taken place as evidenced by crumbling façade, roof damage, broken windows, interior walls crumbling, unsafe flooring on the second floor, no HVAC system, front porch columns needing to be replaced, etc.;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Warrick County Commissioners that the following property of Warrick County, Indiana hereby be designated as a historic structure in need of redevelopment as defined by Indiana Code 36-7-14:

124 E. Main Street, Boonville, IN, 47601.
