

RESOLUTION 2017- 09

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
WARRICK COUNTY, INDIANA, REGARDING
THE DONATION OF SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, Warrick County, Indiana, is in possession of approximately forty (40) used filing cabinets, which have been declared as surplus personal property of Warrick County; and

WHEREAS, Indiana Code §5-22-22 *et seq.* controls the disposition of surplus personal property owned by a political subdivision such as Warrick County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Indiana Code §5-22-22-10, a purchasing agency may exchange property with another governmental body upon agreed terms and conditions as evidenced by the adoption of substantially identical resolutions by each entity; and


WHEREAS, Warrick County, Indiana, through its Purchasing Agent is willing to exchange and donate the surplus filing cabinets pursuant to Indiana Code §5-22-22-10 to the City of Boonville, located in Warrick County, and to the Dubois County Sheriff's Department, and those respective units are willing to accept said filing cabinets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Warrick County, Indiana, as follows:

That pursuant to Indiana Code 5-22-22 *et seq.*, the Board of Commissioners of Warrick County, Indiana, has agreed to exchange and donate used filing cabinets which it have declared as surplus personal property, to the City of Boonville and the Dubois County Sheriff's Department. Furthermore, the City of Boonville and the Dubois County Sheriff's Department are willing to accept said filing cabinets.

Passed and adopted by the Warrick County Board of Commissioners this 13th day of March, 2017.






