RESOLUTION NO. 2017-11**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WARRICK
COUNTY, INDIANA, ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT AND
MAXIMUM VEHICLE WEIGHT LIMIT**

WHEREAS, Indiana Code Section 36-9-2 *et seq.* authorizes the Board of Commissioners of Warrick County, Indiana, to regulate the use of public ways; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Warrick County, Indiana, has the authority to declare a reasonable and safe maximum speed limit on public highways within its jurisdiction pursuant to Indiana Code Section 9-21-5-6; and

WHEREAS, Section 70.01 of the Code of Ordinance of Warrick County provides that the Board of Commissioners may by resolution post maximum speed limits on county highways; and

WHEREAS, Section 70.02 of the Code of Ordinance of Warrick County provides that the Board of Commissioners may by resolution post a maximum vehicle weight limit on county highways; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 70.01 and 70.02 of the Code of Ordinance of Warrick County, the Warrick County Highway Department shall have the power to place and maintain traffic control signs, signals and devices when and as required in order to regulate traffic in accordance with the declaration and determination of the Warrick County Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Warrick County Highway Engineer conducted a traffic investigation and recommended to the Warrick County Board of Commissioners that a maximum speed limit and maximum gross vehicle weight limit be posted to regulate traffic and promote safety on Shilo Road, located in Boonville, Warrick County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the Warrick County Board of Commissioners reviewed the recommendation of the Warrick County Highway Engineer and now wish to adopt a maximum speed limit and gross maximum vehicle weight limit on Shilo Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Warrick County, Indiana, as follows:

The maximum speed limit shall be Thirty (30) miles per hour, and the maximum gross vehicle weight limit shall be Ten (10) tons or Twenty Thousand (20,000) pounds effective for **SHILO ROAD**, located in Boonville, Warrick County, Indiana. Furthermore, no vehicle with a gross weight in

excess of Ten (10) tons or Twenty Thousand (20,000) pounds shall be operated on or across said road without express permit of the Warrick County Board of Commissioners.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Warrick County Highway Department shall post the respective maximum speed limit and maximum gross vehicle weight as set out above with appropriate signs, and that the penalty provisions of Section 70.99 of the Warrick County Code of Ordinances shall apply to this resolution.






