

WARRICK COUNTY COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 2019 - 02

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND PERMITTING DISBURSEMENTS FROM THE
JAIL COMMISSARY FUND, PURUSANT TO INDIANA CODE § 36-8-10-21.**

WHEREAS, the Warrick County Council (“Council”) is the fiscal body of Warrick County, Indiana (the “County”); and

WHEREAS, I.C. § 36-8-10-21 provides for the establishment of a jail commissary fund (the “Fund”) into which the County Sheriff, or his designee, (“Sheriff”) deposits all money received from commissary sales; and

WHEREAS, I.C. § 36-8-10-21(d)(1)-(8) provides the Sheriff may disburse money from the Fund for certain enumerated purposes without appropriation by the Council; and

WHEREAS, I.C. § 36-8-10-21(d)(9) provides the Sheriff may disburse money from the Fund for any other purpose that benefits the Sheriff’s department that is mutually agreed upon by the Sheriff and the Council; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff has determined that the following purposes benefit the Sherriff’s department:

1. All forms of training and conferences associated with the duties of the Sheriff’s department;
2. Reimbursement for expense of inmates in transit;
3. Reimbursement for lost or damaged inmate property;
4. Postage for indigent inmates;
5. Shipping costs regarding department equipment or evidence;
6. Supplies or equipment to promote educational activities for inmates;
7. Reimbursement for investigation expenses;
8. Expenses for advertising community events that promote the Sheriff’s department;
9. Reimbursement for damaged employee property;
10. Matching funds for grants;
11. Sheriff’s department cell phone contract and equipment;
12. Expenses for installation and service of department equipment;
13. Expenses for contracting with professional consultants;

14. Expenses associated with rental/purchase of specialized equipment, including vehicles to be utilized by the Sheriff's department;
15. Expenses associated with special events for inmates or employees such as Holiday Events, Retirement Events, Recognition Events, etc.;
16. Expenses regarding special details or investigations;
17. Expenses associated with hosting training events; and
18. Any purpose that benefits the Sheriff's department that does not exceed \$2,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council has determined and mutually agrees that the above purposes benefit the Sherriff's department and that it is in the best interest of the County to allow the Sheriff's department to make disbursements from the commissary fund for said purposes.




